Eligibility:

- Must be an FFA member in good standing

Jerry L. Biggs Memorial Scholarship from California FFA. Applicant must be an FFA member, must hold an FFA State Degree, must pursue higher education and must be majoring in agriculture education focused on teaching high school agriculture. Application is due 2/1/2019.

Paul Freitas Memorial Scholarship from California FFA. Applicant must be an FFA member, must hold an FFA State Degree, must pursue higher education with a degree in agriculture and applicant must have an SAE project in sheep production. Due 2/1/2019.
